



MASTER OF HEALTH INFORMATICS & HEALTH INFORMATION MANAGEMENT

Information technology is transforming the health care industry, giving providers ready access to electronic health records and other information that can vastly improve health care.

The University of Washington's Master of Health Informatics & Health Information Management program prepares you to step into leadership and technology roles in the development and management of enterprise-level health information systems. Our 18-month program begins each autumn and offers a unique curriculum that combines leadership development with in-depth training in the rapidly changing field of health IT. Our program is accredited by the Commission on Accreditation for Health Informatics and Information Management Education (CAHIIM).

The Master of Health Informatics & Health Information Management program is designed for professionals working in health care settings who want to advance into mid- and senior-level leadership roles in health informatics and health information management. The program also serves IT and business professionals who want to apply their skills to enter a health-related field.

A new cohort starts every fall. This program is offered over 3 consecutive days a month in a "hyflex" format with students electing to attend in person or join online for a synchronous class experience.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited college or university in the United States, or its equivalent from a foreign institution, preferably in business, information technology, health informatics, health management or a health-related field
- A minimum 3.0 GPA (on a 4.0 scale) for the last 60 graded semester credits or 90 graded quarter credits
- Demonstrated English language proficiency for applicants whose native language is not English
- International students must have a visa status that allows for academic study at the University of Washington



REQUIRED APPLICATION MATERIALS

- UW Graduate School online application and fee
- Unofficial transcripts from each college or university where a degree was earned
- Resume or curriculum vitae
- Written statements
- 3 Professional recommendations
